Arrangements for Free School Meals for w/c 23 March 2020

The school will be open for a very limited number children of Critical Workers from Monday 23 March 2020. This is to reduce the exposure of families during the COVID-19 pandemic. The school is not open for other students.

Below are the arrangement for students who are eligible for a free school meal.

Free School Meals

We are grateful to Robertson FM, our catering contractor, for putting on a trial next week, with regard to the distribution of free school meals to students who attend Outwood Academy Normanby.

All eligible students are invited to arrive at the academy between the hours of 12.30pm-1.00pm to collect a lunch to then take away. There will be no facilities for students to sit and eat their meal.

In the first instance, on Monday and Tuesday of next week, the free school meal available will simply be a 'grab bag' containing a sandwich (selection of ham, cheese, egg or tuna), a cheese portion, a Popcorn bag (lightly salted), water and a fruit portion.

We ask that all eligible students arrive between 12.30pm-1.00pm on Monday and Tuesday, in order to complete a quick survey to allow us to provide hot food choices moving forwards. Students can choose to 'order' a panini, pizza slice, pasta pot, jacket potato with filling or sandwich, and we anticipate these greater options will then be available from Wednesday 25 March.

Please note this is a one week trial in the first instance, whilst we also consider supermarket voucher options once the government provides more details.

Thank you for your understanding and patience as we plan for Monday, and then settle into completely new routines and approaches to learning.
