Enforced Partial School Closure to Year 8 - Tuesday 29 March 2022

The health, safety and welfare of our students, staff, families and the community are at the forefront of the decisions we make as a school. It is with regret that we have had to make the decision to carry out an enforced partial closure to **Year 8** tomorrow. Unfortunately staffing levels are very low which means that we cannot safely accommodate all students within the academy. We have made the decision to close to Year 8 students on **Tuesday 29 March**. Year 8 students should return to school as normal on **Wednesday 30 March**.

Home Learning

We have a strong plan in place for home learning via Google Classroom. Students should be up and logging on by 8.30am in preparation for the start of Period 1 at 8.45am. Year 8 students should follow their normal timetable for the day by visiting the correct subject Google Classrooms at the correct times, as shown in their planner. Lessons will have work posted into each subject classroom for students to complete.

All students have been shown how to access Google Classroom and we have checked that they have their login and password details. Students have been given a sticker with this information which will be in their planner.
